**BEN ̄\\_(\ツ)\\_/̄ KANTOR**



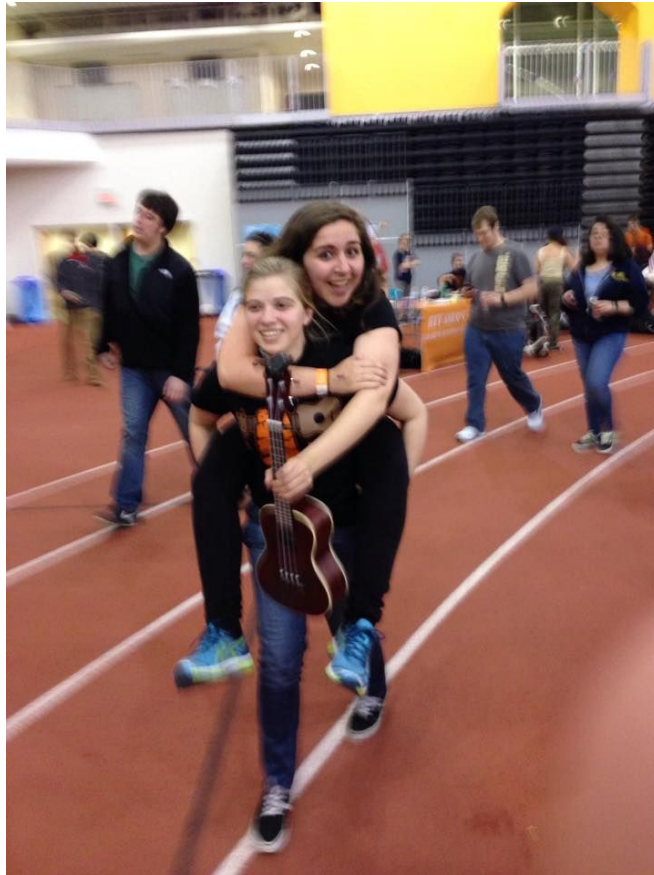

## JACKIE “JUKEBOX BLIZZARD WIZARD” WILEY

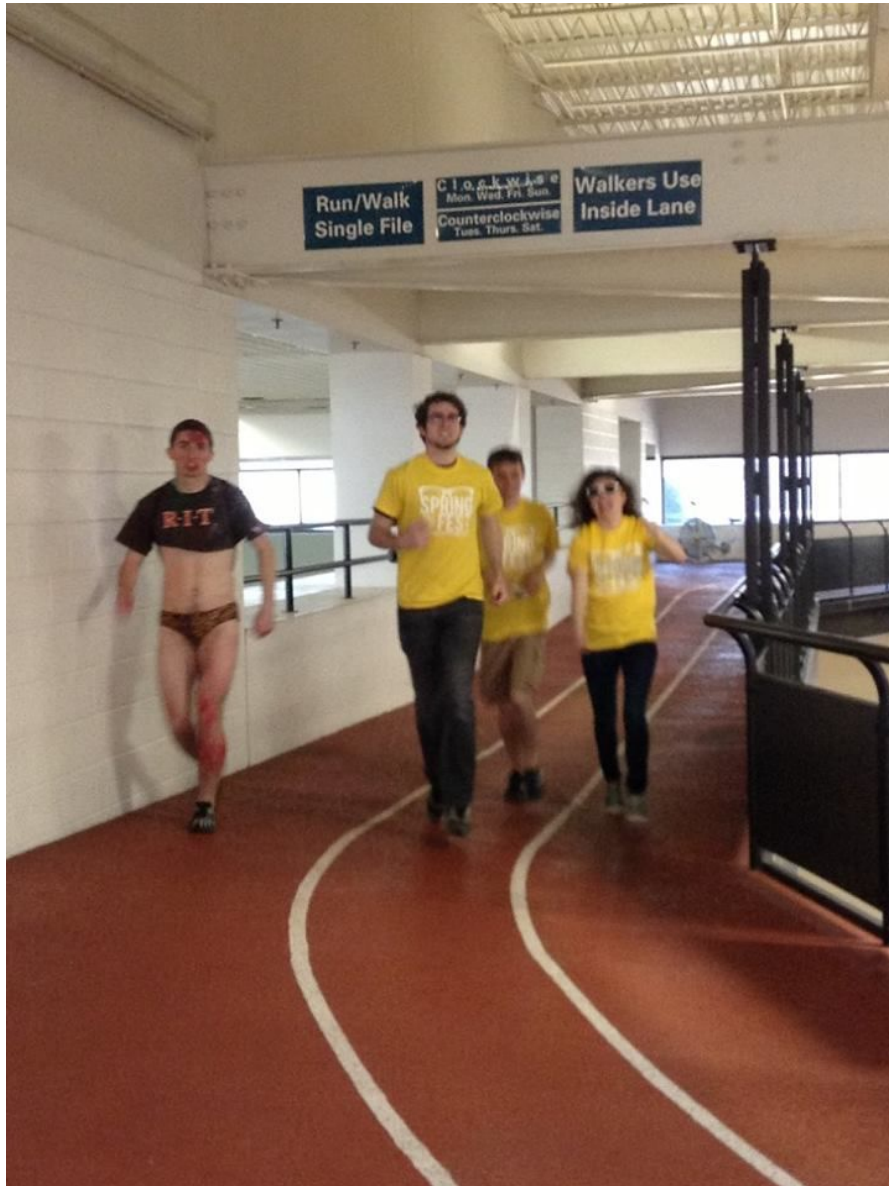
